
OUR INSTITUTION




OI GOALS





- European Union set very challenging goals for recycling and for reducing the quantity of waste deposited in landfills;
- From 100 % generated municipal waste, it was determined according studies that 28,71 % are recyclable wastes.
- For 2021, Romania had a target to collect separately 60 % from the total amount of recyclable waste;
- By 2030, Romania must deposit in landfills only 35 % from total municipal waste generated;
- According to law, local public authorities must collect municipal waste on 4 fractions — plastic / metal, cardboard / paper, glass and residual waste;

O2 REALITY



The current situation in Bistrita-Nasaud County


- Bistrita-Nasaud was the first county in Romania to have an Integrated
 Waste Management System developed on the entire surface of the
 county;
- The **total value** of the project was of **41,3 mil**. **Euro**, mostly funded through **European funds**, and was implemented between 2009 2015;
- 968 platforms with semi-buried containers were built within this project;
- During this period, adjustments were made in order to make this system more efficient;
- In 2020 were distributed to population 60.000 yellow bins for plastic / metal recyclable wastes;
- The platforms with semi-buried containers were used only for recyclable waste collection;











- In 2021, in Bistrita-Nasaud County were collected 8.700 tons of recyclable waste, from which were sorted 6.200 tons;
- 930 tons of recyclable waste were capitalized (sold) almost 15 % from sorted quantity (average in Romania is 11 %);



WASTE POLICE

The main tasks of the officers from Waste Police are:

- Checking and monitoring the way individuals are collecting separately the recyclable waste;
- Checking and monitoring the way companies are collecting separately the recyclable waste;
- Verifying the way the sanitation operators fulfill their contractual obligations;
- Control actions designed to prevent the abandon of waste in the natural environment;

COLLECTING FROM THE GATE

One of the major changes in the actual system of collecting recyclable waste is the "collecting from the gate" for all 3 recyclable fractions — plastic / metal, glass, paper and for residual waste as well for all housing areas in the county;

- Individuals from this area will not have to go anymore to the collecting platforms with semi-buried containers for depositing the paper and the glass;
- Individuals will be better monitored in the process of separate collection of the waste
